WRAP Seminar II trains individuals in the skills for facilitating Wellness Recovery Action Plans (WRAP) in a group format or in a 1:1 peer setting.

WRAP Seminar II is **NOT** for learning about the WRAP Tool. All candidates applying are expected to have an understanding of WRAP and will be asked to demonstrate that knowledge in various exercises during the course.

To be considered for a WRAP Seminar II Class, each individual is expected to:

- **Be using a personal WRAP to live their own wellness**

- **Provide certification of having completed a WRAP Seminar One class**
- **Have an email address to receive communications and attachments**

This training is open to candidates internal and external to Keystone. Applications for WRAP Seminar II are due by **January 16, 2017**. Registrations will be assessed on a first come, first serve basis. A waiting list will be maintained when capacity is reached. Applicants will be notified of status. Limited “scholarships” available.
