What: Certified Peer Specialist Training Program, Youth and Young Adult Focus (CPS 200)

Description: The Institute has been authorized by the State Office of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (OMHSAS) to train and certify Peer Support Specialists in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania since 2007.

The Certified Peer Specialist curriculum focuses on the principles and philosophy of recovery and, throughout the course relates to individuals by applying their personal lived experiences to the core skills, knowledge and beliefs of peer-to-peer support.

This course is intended for individuals who meet the OMHSAS criteria to be trained as CPS, who have never completed the CPS course AND are aged 18-30 years.
